Tuesday Services At Kellogg For Mrs. Lyle Blum

Mrs. Lyle (Sara Agnes) Blum, 43, resident of Kellogg for the past 32 years, died Sunday morning at a Newton hospital.

Funeral services were held Tuesday afternoon from the Kellogg Christian church with the Rev. Herbert Miller, pastor, officiating. Interment was in Our Sincere City cemetery at Kellogg.

Born at Gilman on Feb. 11th, 1921, she was the daughter of James and Elizabeth Hilton McKibbin. She was educated in the Jasper county schools and graduated from Newton high school in 1939.

On Oct. 20th., 1943, she was united in marriage with Lyle Blum at Chillicothe, Mo.

Survivors include her husband, Lyle; a son, Terry Lee, and a daughter, Mary Ann, both at home; two sisters, Mrs. James (Priscilla) Anderson and Mrs.

Ray (Peggy) Willemsen, both of Kellogg; two brothers, James McKibbin of Grinnell and John McKibbin of Baxter.

Preceding her in death were her parents and one sister. Mrs. Blum was a member of the Order of Eastern Star and the Kellogg Christian church.
