

Harris Boat services held

Harris E. Boat, 77, of 206 Fifth Ave., Sully, died of cancer Friday, May 2, at Skiff Medical Center in Newton.

Funeral services were conducted at 10:30 a.m. Tuesday at the First Reformed Church in Sully, with the Rev. Willis Thiessen, pastor of the Sully Community Church, officiating. Burial was in the Sully Cemetery.
