
**DR. DAN BRADLEY,
FORMER COLLEGE PRESIDENT
PASSES AWAY IN CLEVELAND.**

News reports reaching Grinnell early this week, announced the death by heart attack of Dr. Dan Bradley, a former president of Grinnell college and retired Congregational minister. At the time of his death Rev. Mr. Bradley was 82 years of age. From 1902 until 1937 he had been pastor of the Pilgrim Congregational church in Cleveland. He had come to Cleveland from his home in Birmingham, Michigan, to be in attendance at the anniversary celebration of his former church.

Dr. Bradley was a graduate of Oberlin college. In 1889 he was ordained to the ministry and was later appointed president of Yankton college in Yankton, N. D. After serving there for a period of five years he came to Grinnell college on a three year contract as president. He resigned in 1905 to accept the Cleveland pastorate.

He is survived by three sons, Rev. Dwight J. of New York City, Dan T. of Detroit, Mich., and Robert G. Bradley of Birmingham, Michigan.

Mr. Bradley will be remembered well by many Grinnell people. He was possessed of a genial personality and ability as a speaker.

During his period of service as the head of the college, he was immensely interested in the beautifying of the campus. Many of the lovely trees on the campus were planted by his efforts. The Bradley oaks on the north campus were dedicated to him only a few years ago.
