

## Cynthia Braley memorial set

Cynthia Braley, 57, of Rte. 1, Kellogg, died Thursday, April 4, at University Hospitals in Iowa City.

A memorial service will be conducted at 11 a.m. Tuesday at the Reese Chapel in Newton, with John Claussen of Killduff officiating. The body was cremated.
