Wallace Braley, 68, of Rte. 2, Kellogg, died Tuesday, April 10, at Grinnell General Hospital.

The body was cremated. A memorial service was conducted Saturday at the Kellogg Christian Church, with the Rev. M.W. Johnson officiating.

The son of Leo and Ethel Holmdahl Braley, he was born Sept. 14, 1921, at Kilduff. He attended Jasper County schools.
