

## Freda Brand services set

Freda M. Brand, 73, of Sully died Tuesday afternoon, Sept. 16, at Friendship Manor in Grinnell.

Funeral services will be conducted at 1:30 p.m. Friday at the Sully First Reformed Church, with the Revs. Daniel Hakken and Ralph Menning officiating. Burial will be in the Sully Cemetery, with the Van Dyk-Duven Funeral Home of Pella in charge of arrangements.
