Roscoe C. Brand, 74, of 138 Highway T38 S., Grinnell, died early Thursday at Grinnell Regional Medical Center. *June 8*

Funeral services were conducted Saturday at the First Reformed Church of Sully, with the Revs. Ralph Menning and Brice Hoyt officiating. Burial was in Sully Cemetery, with the Van Dyk-Duven Funeral Home in charge of arrangements.
