

Carl Brauer rites Tuesday

Carl Brauer, 71, of 610 Pearl St., Grinnell, died Saturday morning at Grinnell General Hospital.

Funeral services for Mr. Brauer will be held at 10 a.m. Tuesday at the Smith Funeral Home, with the Rev. Hugh A. Shiveley, pastor of the First Baptist Church, officiating.
