Gilbert Breckenridge, 68, died in an Ames hospital on Tuesday, Dec. 20, of a lingering illness. Funeral services were held on Thursday at 10:30 in the Collegiate Church. Graveside services were held that afternoon in the Forest cemetery in Brooklyn.

Born in Brooklyn, he attended the Brooklyn public schools graduating in 1916. He was graduated from Iowa State University at Ames in 1932. Following ten years in the hardware business in Brooklyn and employment in Ames. His degrees were in Industrial Education and in Mechanical Engineering. He was made an associate professor in 1956, in the department of Mechanical engineering.

He was married to Mildred McLain of Brooklyn in 1921. He is survived by his wife, one son, Bruce Breckenridge of St. Louis, by three daughters, Mrs. Harriet Turkington of Norman, Oklahoma; Mrs. Esther Blackburn of Baltimore, Maryland and Mrs. Eleanor Gates of College Station, Texas.
