Alice Breniman, 91, of the Golden West Nursing Home, Fort Collins, Colo. died Tuesday, Oct. 9, 1979 following a prolonged illness. Funeral services were held at 1:30 p.m. Monday, October 15 at the Warren Funeral Chapel. Burial was in Grandview Cemetery, Fort Collins.
