Mollie Belle Weatherbe was born in Lincoln township, Poweshick county, Ia., Aug. 2, 1872, and passed away at University hospital, Iowa City, May 14, 1935.

She graduated from the Victor high school in 1889 and taught very successfully in the public schools for two years.

March 30, 1892, she was united in marriage with Frederick F. Breniman and to this union were born three daughters, Mrs. Alma McSherry and Mrs. Ada Forehand of Brooklyn and Mrs. Ruby Sarah Gloe of Ft. Collins, Colo. There are seven grandchildren, two nieces, Mrs. Belle Fowler of Brooklyn and Mrs. Ruth Salome of Cedar Rapids, Ia., with a host of relatives and friends who will greatly miss the passing of this fine character.

When quite young, Mrs. Breniman united with the Sunset Methodist church and later on transferred to the Moravian church in Warren township. When the family moved to Colorado, she transferred her membership to Ft. Collins. When they returned, she transferred to the Brooklyn church, of which she remained a faithful member as long as she lived. She served in a number of offices in the church, whose organizations always came first. She served as communion steward until she went to her crowning. She was a member of the O. E. S. in Brooklyn and served as one of the officers until her decease. She was a member of the W. R. C. in this city and took an active part in the work of this organization.
