LYNNVILLE (Special)—
Funeral services for Freada
M. Brignon, 68, the wife of
Glenn Brignon of Searsboro,
were held Thursday, July 26, at
the Friends Church in Lynn-
ville. Mrs. Brignon died
Monday, July 23, at Iowa
Methodist Hospital in Des
Moines.

The daughter of Albert R.
and Myrle J. Meredith, she was
born April 3, 1905. She lived in
the Lynnville and Searsboro
vicinity all her life. A graduate
of Lynnville High School, she
attended Iowa State Teachers
College and later was
graduated from Drake
University.

Mrs. Brignon taught school
for many years in the Lynn-
ville, Sully, and Searsboro
schools. For nine years prior to
her retirement, she taught at
Davis School in Grinnell. She
was awarded a lifetime
membership in the Iowa State
Education Association (ISEA)
following her 36 years of
teaching.

She was a member of the
Friends Church in Lynnville
and also attended the Friends
Church in Searsboro where she
occasionally assisted as
organist or pianist.

Mrs. Brignon was a member
of the Mary White Chapter,
Order of Eastern Star, at
Lynnville for many years and
served as worthy matron of
that chapter. Later she was
affiliated with Newton Chapter
No. 11, and on May 7 of this
year received recognition for
50 years of membership. She
was also a member of the
Rebecca Lodge at Searsboro
and was noble grand of the
Rebeccas. She was a member
of the Women's Club in Lynn-
ville, the Hillcrest Garden
Club, and the Sewing Circle.

She was preceded in death by
a brother, Kenneth Gerald
Meredith, in 1920. Survivors
include her husband; her
parents, Mr. and Mrs. Albert
R. Meredith of Grinnell; one
sister, Treva M. Etting of
Grinnell; three brothers,
Marshall G. Meredith of
Lynnville, Merlin W. Meredith
of Marine City, Mic., and
Rayford L. Meredith of
Newton; 11 nieces and
nephews; 17 great-grand
nieces and nephews; and
several other relatives.

The Rev. Irene Weitert of-
ficiated at Thursday's ser-
vices, with the Rev. Delano
Cunningham assisting.
