Funeral Services Held For Harvey H. Brown

Funeral services were held last Wednesday, Feb. 21, at the Lynnville Friends church for Harvey Harold Brown, who died at 1 p.m. Feb. 19 at Grinnell General Hospital East.

The Rev. Peter Schuler officiated at the services. Homer McDowell was vocalist and Harriet Macy was organist. Pallbearers were Weibe Goodyke, David Gertsma, Ray Ver Steeg, Albert Terpstra, Lloyd Sparks, and Ernest Graham.

Harden Funeral Home in New Sharon had charge of the arrangements.

Mr. Brown was born Jan. 10, 1893, in Taintor, Iowa, in Mahaska County, the son of Frank and Anna DeBruyn Brown. He received his education in the schools of that area and in Lynnville.

On Jan. 10, 1917, Mr. Brown married Mary E. Thompson at Newton. To this union were born two sons, Leonard H. and Floyd R. of Moline Ill., and two daughters, Evelyn Arthur of Searsboro and Dorothy Louise, who died in infancy.

Mr. Brown farmed in the Grinnell and Lynnville area and was a feed salesman for the Moorman Manufacturing Co. of Quincy, Ill., for 15 years.

Survivors include his widow, Mary; two sons, one daughter, 12 grandchildren, and five great-grandchildren.

Mr. Brown was preceded in death by his parents, one brother, Tracey; one sister, Ocea, and an infant brother, David.
