
OLIVER CLARK BROWN IS BURIED IN EWART

Former Resident of This County Dies
1-29- in Peoria, Ill. 1924

Oliver Clark Brown was born in Poweshiek County, Iowa, June 1, 1863 and died at Proctor hospital in Peoria, Illinois, January 21, 1924, at the age of 60 years 7 months and 21 days.

He was married to Parazada Gunter of Hitchcock County, Nebraska, May 2, 1886.

To this union were born five children, three boys and two girls, two of whom, one boy, Samuel at the age of eight years, and one daughter, aged 21 years, preceded him to the better world. He leaves two sons Andrew and Bennie, and one daughter Liddie, all of Peoria, Illinois, one sister of Niobrara, Nebraska, four cousins, B. B. Martin and sons, Levi and Jess Martin of Montezuma and John Evans of Marengo, and a host of other relatives and friends to mourn the loss of a loving father and respected friend and neighbor.

After his marriage he moved from Nebraska to Mahaska County, Iowa, where he resided about four years, then moved to Poweshiek county where they resided about 12 years. During this time his wife departed to her Heavenly home. Feb. 7, 1906, at the age of 38 years, he moved to Peoria, Illinois, in December 1908 and resided there until his death.

The body was brought to Ewart Thursday and funeral services were held in the U. P. church at 2 o'clock conducted by Rev. R. E. Lackey of Ewart. Mrs. C. L. Braley sang several solos. The body was laid to rest in Clover Hill cemetery.

Mr. Brown, having lived in our vicinity for a number of years was well known by a good many of our people.
