Mrs. Parazada Brown was born in Monmouth, Illinois, May 5, 1867 and moved to Red Oak, Iowa, when eleven years old and afterwards to Hitchcock County, Nebraska. She was married to Oliver Brown in Nebraska in 1886 afterwards moving to Jacobs, Iowa, where Mr. Brown is a blacksmith.
