William Albert Bryan

William Albert Bryan was born in Jefferson county, Iowa, Sept. 8, 1848, and departed this life June 5, 1917, being at the time of his demise 68 years, 8 months and 27 days of age.

At Fairfield, Iowa, September 9, 1875, he was united in marriage to Mary E. Parker. To this union eight children were born, two of whom with the wife have preceded him to eternity. The living children are Mrs. Mabel Dunton and Mrs. Grace Lavake, of Montezuma, Mrs. Mattie Callison and Mrs. Blanche Litzenberg, of Grinnell, Ernest Bryan, of Barnes City, and Chas. Bryan, of Malcom.
