

## Kellogg Man's 5-12-1931 Funeral Today

Nels Buck, for the past 55 years a resident of Kellogg and well known in Grinnell, died at his home Saturday evening at 11:15 o'clock following a two weeks' illness. He suffered a paralytic stroke while out walking May 3 and failed to recover. He had been in failing health for the past winter. He celebrated his seventy-seventh birthday Nov. 3 of last year.

Funeral services were held from the Christian church this afternoon at 2 o'clock with Rev. W. B. Wilson of Newburg, a former pastor, officiating.

Preceding him in death were his wife and one daughter and he is survived by two daughters, Mrs. W. T. Parsons of Malcom, Ia., and Mrs. S. F. Hartwig of Kellogg; one granddaughter, Mrs. E. C. Starrett of Newton; one great-grandson, John Parsons Starrett of Newton; four nephews, three of them in Denmark and the fourth, Carl Paulson in Brooklyn; and one niece in Denmark.
