

Former Grinnell 8-28-1928 Girl Is Dead

Word has been received from Milwaukee announcing the sudden death there at 2:30 Wednesday morning of Mrs. Arthur S. Burnell, formerly a well-known resident of Grinnell.

Mrs. Burnell was born Florence Sears, and was the second daughter of the late Dr. Reuben and Cynthia Guild Sears, who moved to Marshalltown from Grinnell in 1873. Mrs. Burnell was a native of this state and her early girlhood was passed at Brooklyn, where Dr. Sears was an early practitioner, 1855 to 1863. Mrs. Burnell was about 74 years of age.

Mr. and Mrs. Burnell made their home in Marshalltown many years following their marriage, and left there 22 years ago. They made their home in Webster City several years and then moved to Milwaukee. Mr. Burnell was in the job printing business in Marshalltown years ago, and later, for several years, published a credit rating report for different counties and the Interstate Tracer, a weekly newspaper which dealt with credit in the different communities in which it was circulated.
