Cloyd M. Carl, 81, of Montezuma, Ia., died Thursday, Oct. 13, 1994 at Grinnell Regional Medical Center in Grinnell, Ia.

Funeral services were held at 1:30 p.m., Saturday, Oct. 15, 1994, at Watts Funeral Home, Montezuma. Rev. Brian Carter, United Methodist Church, Montezuma, officiated the services. Miss Alice Underwood was organist with music selection of "How Great Thou Art." Honorary casket bearers were his grandchildren Shane Carl, Kevin Carl, Anthony Carl, Scott Carl, Kerri Carl and Olivia Harper.
