Gage G. Carman Services Tuesday

Gage Griffin Carman, who has been a resident of Mayflower Home since July, 1966, died March 29 en route to Grinnell from Orlando, Fla., where he and his wife had spent the winter.

Born in Charleston, Ill., Mr. Carman attended school there. He attended the Eastern Illinois Normal School, and was later awarded the degrees of Bachelor of Science and Master of Science at the University of Illinois.

He taught in the Salem, Ill. high school for one year and in Paseo High School, Central High School and the junior college at Kansas City, Mo.; for 40 years.

At the University of Illinois, he was a member of Gamma Alpha graduate fraternity.

In Grinnell, Mr. Carman was a member of the United Church of Christ — Congregational.

He is survived by his wife Lucile, his sister Ruth of Charleston, Ill., and his brother Dr. Max Carman of Murray, Ky.

Mr. Carman served as chairman for the house-to-house canvass for the United Fund. He was also active in many programs at Mayflower Home.

Memorial services for Mr. Carman will be held at 10 a.m. Tuesday at the chapel in Mayflower Home, with the Rev. Newell Davis and Chaplain Lawrence Murphy officiating.
