Mr. Ray T. Carter, Former Grinnellian, Dies In Marshalltown

Ray Carter, 65, of Marshalltown and formerly of Grinnell, died Sunday morning in Evangelical Hospital in Marshalltown where he had been a patient for four weeks.

Services for Mr. Carter were held at 2 p.m. yesterday (July 12) at the Estel-Perrin Funeral Home in Marshalltown with the Rev. Dr. James Delahooke, pastor of the Methodist Church, officiating. Burial was in Riverside Cemetery.

Mr. Carter was born in Grinnell on Nov. 1, 1901 to Thomas J. and Hettie May Holmes Carter. On May 18, 1946 he married Desie Ausdal.

After their marriage the couple moved where Mr. Carter worked at the Fisher Governor Co. as a machinist. He was a member of the Fisher 10 and 25 Year Clubs.

Survivors include his wife; his mother—Mrs. Thomas Carter of Marshalltown and formerly of Grinnell; one sister—Mrs. Harold Hays of Marshalltown.
