We noted in Friday's issue the death at her St. Paul home early Friday morning of Mrs. Belle Bliss Cash. The body was brought to Grinnell for burial, the funeral occurring Sunday at 4 o'clock at the home of her father, Harvey Bliss, conducted by Prof. S. J. Buok. The deceased woman was born at Springfield, Ill., March 17, 1863, making her age 38 years and five months. She was adopted into the family of Deacon Bliss in 1870. She lived as a daughter in their home until about 20 years of age. She then passed three years at Des Moines. June 24, 1886, she was married to M. T. Cash and has recently been a resident of St. Paul, Minn. Two children were born to this union, Ethel aged 11 and Frankie aged 12. Her children were brought up to attend Sunday school and her life was that of a model wife and mother. Nearly a year ago a cancer began to do its dreaded work and the expert medical skill was called to her aid it was unavailing. She last came to Grinnell last April at the time of her mother's death, altho suffering much with disease. Her body rests in Hazelwood near that of her mother. Mr. M. T. Cash, the husband, with his two children, Ethel and Frankie, accompanied the body to Grinnell. Also his parents, Mr. and Mrs. Cash of St. Paul, his sister, Miss Jennie Cash, a teacher in the Boone, Iowa, schools, and a cousin, Mr. Frank Crandall, of West Superior.
