

L. S. Chidester Called By Death

Former Grinnell Citizen Passes Away
At His Home in Leeds, New York.

Frank Cass, who is one of the old timers in this community, has just brought us word of the death of L. S. Chidester, a former resident of Grinnell who has been living the last twenty years at Leeds, New York. Mr. Chidester for many years occupied the farm north of Snow's Corner where Mrs. M. M. Belden now lives and all of the residents of twenty or more years ago remember both Mr. and Mrs. Chidester as generous hearted, kindly, and successful farmers. Mr. Chidester died February 20 at his home and is survived by his wife. The following obituary notice is taken from a New York paper:

Lyman S. Chidester died Feb. 20th at his home in Leeds, aged seventy-seven years. The funeral took place Tuesday, the Rev. George Wood officiating. Burial was in the Jefferson Rural Cemetery. Deceased was born at Cairo Junction, the son of Samuel and Elizabeth Lampman Chidester,

and grew up in this locality, where he followed the occupation of farming. For a time he lived at Grinnell, Iowa, but returned about twenty years ago to Catskill, and had since resided here where he was well liked and respected by all who knew him. His wife (Adelle Robins) survives him.

Mr. Chidester had been in failing health a number of years.
