TAYLOR CLARK

Taylor Clark was born at Centerville, July 15, 1893, the son of the late Grant Clark and Minerva Taylor Clark. He died suddenly Wednesday, Dec. 19, 1956, following a heart attack.

On Dec. 18, 1912, he was united in marriage with Amelia Schultz, who survives. They were the parents of eight children. Two daughters preceded him in death. Surviving children are Mrs. J. E. Caretaker at the Newburg consolidated school and a Newburg resident for more than 46 years, Mr. Clark had observed his 44th wedding anniversary only the day preceding his death.

Funeral services were held Saturday at the Newburg Congregational church with the Rev. Helen Turner officiating. Burial was at Hickory Grove cemetery.
