Amy H. Clay, 80, of Lyndhurst, Ohio, formerly of the Newburg area, died Saturday, March 9, at Hillcrest Hospital in Mayfield Heights, Ohio.

Funeral services were conducted at 1:30 p.m. Tuesday at the Smith Funeral Home here, with the Rev. Kenneth Wallace, pastor of the Newburg-Chester Parish, officiating. Organist was Alice Renaud, and pallbearers were Bart Anderson, John Anderson, Elmer Burnson, Wendell Paul, Chris Phipps, Dennis Weaver and Steve Zyzanski. Burial was in the Hickory Grove Cemetery west of Newburg.

The daughter of Roy and Mary Larsen Anderson, she was born Oct. 18, 1904, in Grinnell. She was a graduate of Grinnell High School and later attended Grinnell College.

In September 1936, she was married to Ralph Dewey Clay in Cedar Rapids. They farmed in the Newburg area. Mr. Clay died in 1965, and Mrs. Clay remained on the farm until 1980 when she moved to Grinnell. She had spent the past few years with her daughter in Lyndhurst.

She was a member of the Newburg United Church of Christ and the Order of Easter Star in Grinnell.

Survivors include her daughter Jolene Zyzanski of Lyndhurst, and three grandsons. She was preceded in death by her husband, her parents, and two brothers, Nels and Robert Anderson.
