

Funeral Services For Ed. M. Clay

Brief funeral services were held Friday afternoon for Edward M. Clay at the Frank Kennedy home, and burial was made in Hazelwood cemetery. Mr. Clay, who had lived in Grinnell for a number of years, passed away last Wednesday at Marshalltown, and the funeral was held there Thursday.

Mr. Clay was born Nov. 18, 1869, at Mendota, Ill., and came to Iowa with his parents when a child, settling in Jasper county. He was married August 24, 1895, at Newton to Lydia Rowe. They lived on a farm near Newburg for five years and later moved into the town. In 1910 they moved to Grinnell which they made their home until 1923, when they moved to a farm north of Conrad.

Besides his widow, Mr. Clay is survived by two brothers, Hiram W. Clay, of Conrad, and LeRoy G. Clay, of Des Moines and two nephews, Raymond Clay, of Conrad, and Wesley N. Clay, of Liscomb.
