Mrs. Clements rites today

Helen R. Clements, 65, died of an apparent heart attack at her home early Tuesday morning, March 16.

Memorial services will be conducted at 2 p.m. today at St. Paul's Episcopal Church, with the Rev. Robert Towner officiating.
