Carrie Clifton Services Today

(ARTHUR)

Mrs. Carrie Elizabeth Clifton, age 82, of 491 High Street, Grinnell, passed away Saturday morning at Community Hospital. She was born March 6, 1885 at Gilman, Iowa.

Following her education, she was united in marriage with Charles Arthur Clifton on March 11, 1903 in Grinnell. To this union were born two sons and one daughter: Arthur Raymod Clifton, who died June 12, 1964; Mrs. Elizabeth Jeanette Clifton Coon of Hibbing, Minnesota; and Kenneth J. Clifton of Grinnell.

Mrs. Clifton is also survived by 9 grandchildren: Raymond Dale Clifton, Tom Clifton, and Sandra Cooper; Burdette, Chuck, Connie, Dennis, Irwin and Maryanne Coon. She also leaves 13 great grandchildren. Mrs. Clifton was preceded in death by her husband Charles on May 11, 1949; her son Arthur on June 12, 1964; and two brothers, William Renshaw and Clyde Weakley.

Mrs. Clifton had lived in Gilman before moving to Grinnell 64 years ago. She was a member of the Grinnell Seventh Day Adventist Church.

Funeral services for Mrs. Carrie Clifton were held at 3:30 p.m. today at the Smith Funeral Home with Elder Ernest Lundin of the Seventh Day Adventist Church officiating.
