David Cole, 80, of Grinnell died of complications of a stroke Sunday, Aug. 6, at Iowa Methodist Medical Center in Des Moines.

No services are planned.

The son of Elmer David and Flora Cresson Cole Sr., he was born May 9, 1915, in New York. He later moved with his family to Nutley, N.J., where he graduated from high school.
