A Brooklyn man became Poweshiek County's third traffic fatality of the year early Thursday when the car he was driving missed a T-intersection five miles north of Brooklyn.

Dead is Raymond Coleman, 64, of rural Brooklyn, who died at about 2 a.m. Thursday at Grinnell General Hospital. He had been taken to the hospital by a Brooklyn ambulance.

Authorities said he was alone in the car when the accident occurred.

Funeral services for Coleman were held at 11 a.m. Saturday at St. James Lutheran Church in Victor. Burial was at the Calvary Cemetery there.

He is survived by his wife, Velma.
