Janice Colton, 68, of 2005 Spring St., Grinnell, died Tuesday evening, Feb. 19, at Grinnell General Hospital.

Funeral services will be conducted at 1:30 p.m. Saturday at the First Presbyterian Church in Little Rock, Ark., with burial at Pine Bluff, Ark. The Ralph Robinson Funeral Home of Pine Bluff is in charge of arrangements.

The daughter of Charles W. and Allie Mae Howell Colton, she was born July 16, 1916, at Pine Bluff. She graduated from Pine Bluff High School in 1923 and later attended Pine Bluff Business College and Hendrix College.

In 1937, Miss Colton moved to Little Rock where she latter served as executive secretary for former Arkansas Governors Carl Bailey and Orval Faubus. During World War II she had been employed by the Federal Housing Authority in Washington, D.C., and Miami, Fla.

Prior to her retirement in 1980, she worked for the Arkansas Employment Security Division. She was a member of the First Presbyterian Church in Little Rock, the women's society of the church, the American Association of Business Women, Delta Theta Tau, and the Women's City Club of Little Rock.

She is survived by a sister, Phyllis Armstrong of Grinnell. Miss Colton had lived at Park Place here since last July.
