### **Services Held Today For John J. Cook**

Funeral services were held at 10 a.m. today (Monday) at the Chapel of Memories in Waterloo for John J. Cook, 79, of 1533 West St., who died on Saturday morning (Dec. 21) at Grinnell General Hospital East.

The Rev. Ronald Rain, pastor of the Grinnell United Presbyterian church, officiated at the services. Burial was in the Garden of Memories cemetery, Waterloo.

The son of Dirk and Neltje Vroge Cook, Mr. Cook was born Nov. 27, 1889 at Pella. He attended the local schools at Pella and at Newton when the family later moved there. Mr. Cook lived in Waterloo for several years where he was a department manager for Kresge's Variety Store. Following the death of his wife Alice on April 9, 1955, he moved to Grinnell to make his home.

Survivors include his son and daughter, John and Rosenell, both of California, and his three sisters—Mrs. W. H. Mart of Grinnell, Mrs. Charles Ortwieg and Mrs. Katherine Old, both of California.
