Mrs. Carl Cordes Buried Friday

Funeral services for Mrs. Carl (Louise) Cordes of Guernsey were held Friday afternoon, Sept. 24, from St. John's Lutheran Church, Victor, with the Rev. Edmond Weiss officiating. Mrs. Jim Offt was the soloist accompanied by Mrs. LaVern Venzke, organist.

Burial was in Cedar Memorial Cemetery at Cedar Rapids. Serving as casket bearers were Roland Burke, Martin Bayer, Jr., Harlan Burke, Gary Hinrichs, Kenneth Schultz and Bert Ranfeld.

Mrs. Cordes died Tuesday, Sept. 21, at the age of 75. She had been in ill health for some time.

Mrs. Cordes was the former Louise Sophie Nobbe. She was the daughter of Christian and Anna Nobbe and was born in Warden, Ill., on March 12, 1890. On Nov. 9, 1919, she married Carl Cordes in Pleasant Valley, Okla.

In July of 1939 they moved to Iowa and established a home near Guernsey.
