Mary Conley was born in County Down, Ireland, in 1838, and was married to James Corrough in 1853. They came to Wallcott, Iowa, June 21, 1854 and settled on a farm where they resided till the spring of 1868. They then moved to Malcom. Four sons and six daughters were born to this union, of whom all survive her except one daughter, Mary, who died July 7, 1899. Mr. Corrough preceded his wife to the better land on Dec. 19, 1905. She was a church member, having united with the Presbyterian church at Malcom in 1883. She was a good mother and always ready to help any of her neighbors in times of trouble. She died February 4, 1909, at the home of her son, John Corrough, who has ten-

derly cared for her the last few months of her life at his home near Brooklyn. The funeral services were held at the Presbyterian church on Saturday, February 6. Rev. Mr. Benson of Brooklyn conducted the services after which the remains were laid to rest in the Malcom cemetery.
