Funeral services for Mrs. Lurene Cranny, 84, widow of former Grinnell High School Principal T. T. Cranny, were held at 12:30 a.m. today (Thursday) at Sacred Heart Catholic Church in Waterloo.

Graveside rites were held at 3 p.m. here, with burial in the Calvary section of Hazelwood Cemetery.

Mrs. Cranny died Tuesday evening in Waterloo.

She is survived by her daughter, Mrs. Marvæn Felt of Waterloo, two brothers, Charles McKenna of Buckingham, Iowa, and Roy McKenna of Hermora Beach, Calif.; and a sister, Mrs. Ethel Toop of Long Beach, Calif. She was preceded in death by her husband in December of 1965 and her son Robert during World War II.

T. T. Cranny Field at Grinnell High School was named after the late Mr. Cranny.

The daughter of John and Margaret Cavanaugh McKenna, she was born June 1, 1888, in Blessing, Iowa. She was married to Timothy T. Cranny Nov. 6, 1912, at Blessing. The couple came to Grinnell in 1913, where he served as principal for 39 years, retiring in 1951. Mr. and Mrs. Cranny then moved to Waterloo.

The Rev. Leo Kuebrich officiated at the graveside services held today.
