

Aged Resident Of Kellogg Passes Away 1935

Kellogg, Ia., March 5, Special:
Miss Grace Craven, 85, resident of this county since 1867, died at the home of Mrs. Hattie Craven here Wednesday afternoon of last week following a lingering illness. Funeral services were held at the Madsen Funeral Home Friday afternoon at 2 o'clock and burial was made in Our Silent City.

Miss Craven was born in Sodus, Wayne county, New York, April 12, 1850, and came to Iowa in 1867. She lived near Kellogg for a number of years and was a teacher in the rural schools of the county.

In 1900 she and her brother, Clarence Craven, moved to Newton to make their home. The brother was killed in an automobile accident in January 1930, and she came to Kellogg to make her home with Mrs. Hattie Craven about two and a half years ago.

Surviving relatives include a brother, A. B. Craven of this place, and numerous nieces, nephews and cousins.
