Clifford Crews services held

Clifford Lyle Crews, 81, of Lynnville died Monday, March 21, at University Hospitals in Iowa City.

Funeral services were conducted Wednesday at the Lynnville Friends Church, with the Rev. Kenneth Santee officiating. Pallbearers were Brad Crews, Lyle Smith, Gene Smith, Glen Van Genderen, Gerald Beason and Bryce Gause.
