dies Thursday

John M. Crossett Jr., 58, a former associate professor of classics at Grinnell College, died Thursday of carbon monoxide poisoning at his home in Iowa City. Dr. Lewis Jacques, the Johnson County medical examiner, ruled the death a suicide. *Aug. 6*

No funeral services were planned, although visitation was held Sunday at the George L. Gay Funeral Home in Iowa City. Burial was at Enosburg Falls, Vt.

Dr. Crossett was a professor of classics at Cornell College, Mt. Vernon, at the time of his death. He held a Ph.D. degree from Harvard University and had taught at Grinnell College from 1963 to 1970.

Memorial donations in his name may be made to the Cornell College scholarship fund.

He is survived by his wife, Judith of Iowa City; two daughters, Elizabeth of Iowa City and Pamela of Burlington, Vt.; a son, John Crossett III of Burlington, Vt.; his mother, Ethel Crossett of Enosburg Falls; and a sister, Barbara Manosh of East Fairfield, Vt.
