

Area native, Cloyd Cullison dies

Services for a Deep River native, Cloyd E. (Dump) Cullison were held Tuesday, Oct. 9, at the Gaudian-Eldridge Funeral Home at Paullina. Burial was at Prairie View Cemetery near Paullina with military rites by the American Legion.

Mr. Cullison, 84, died Sunday morning, Oct. 7, at the Primghar Hospital after a sudden illness.

He was born Feb. 12, 1895, at Deep River, the son of Jerry and Rachel Kime Cullison. He attended school there and served in France during World War I.

He was married to Marlys Brown on April 17, 1931, at Toledo. They farmed in the Deep River area until moving to Paullina in 1947. Mrs. Cullison died in 1956. He continued farming until he

retired to Paullina in 1960.

He is survived by two daughters, Mrs. Dean (Betty) Einerwold of Sutherland and Linda of Marcus; two sons, Jerry and Ronald, both of Paullina; seven grandchildren; and a sister, Mrs. Phil (Izola) Lamb of Malcom.

He was preceded in death by his parents and three brothers, Alden, Marion and John.
