

## Mrs. Cummings Services Friday

Kathryn E. Cummings, 63, of Malcom died Tuesday evening (July 3) at Grinnell General Hospital, following an extended illness.

The daughter of William and Elizabeth Moses McClure, she was born Feb. 24, 1910, at Malcom. She received her education in the Malcom schools and was a graduate of Malcom High School.

On June 15, 1931, she was married to Raymond W. Cummings at the Presbyterian church in Newton. He preceded her in death Aug. 30, 1966. Since her marriage she had lived in Malcom. For a year she was acting postmaster of Malcom, and for the past several years she served as postal clerk.

Mrs. Cummings was a member of the Malcom Presbyterian Church and the Presbyterian Women's Association. She was worthy matron of the Holly Chapter of the Malcom Eastern Star and worthy high priestess of the White Shrine of Newton. She was also a member of the Malcom Garden Club, Poweshiek Rebekah Lodge No. 67 of Malcom, Women's Business and Professional Club of Grinnell, Past Matrons Club of Eastern Star, and Pythian Sisters Lodge of Grinnell. She was also president of the Ivy Hill Cemetery Association.

Survivors include her daughter, Joan Cummings of Malcom; a sister, Ruth Stewart of Pittsburgh, Pa.; and a brother, Wayne McClure of Malcom. She was preceded in death by her husband, her parents, and an infant brother, William James.
