George R. Curry, 95, of 101 Washington St., Gilman, died Monday evening, Feb. 14, at his home.

Funeral services will be conducted at 1:30 p.m. today at the Gilman United Methodist Church, with Dr. Harold Dellit, pastor of the First United Methodist Church of Fort Dodge, and the Rev. Marilyn Buchanan, pastor of the United Methodist Church of Gilman, officiating. Organist will be Doris Schueler.
