Fred L. Davis, 75, of Grinnell died Friday, May 21, at Friendship Manor.

Funeral services were conducted Monday at the Smith Funeral Home, with the Rev. Lon Lewis, pastor of the Grinnell United Methodist Church, officiating. Organist was Margaret Wheeler, and pallbearers were Rick Barnes, Gordon Canfield, Larry Crawford, Tilford Christianson, Jerry Monroe and Dick Peeler.
