Mabel was born on Feb. 8, 1901
at Norway, Iowa, the daughter of
Jacob Jaeger and Anna Nerison,
immigrants to the United States
from Germany and Norway in
about 1882. Shortly after her birth
the family moved to a farm in the
Spencer, Iowa area, where she
was baptized. She moved with her
family back to the Conroy area
about the age of 4. She spent her
girlhood on a farm north of
Conroy and attended the Hilton
Township School.

She was united in marriage to
Roscoe O. (Boots) Davis, on July
9, 1928 at Cedar Rapids, Iowa.
Boots died in January of 1966.
Mabel worked in several homes in
Iowa County and also was
employed for several years at the
H.R. Shaul Grocery Store in
Ladora. In 1972 she returned to
the Conroy area. She was a life-
time member of the First Luth-
eran Church of Conroy and was a
member of the American
Lutheran Church Women's
organization. She died in her
home in Conroy on Aug. 25, 1986.
