Roland Davis services held

Roland W. Davis, 64, of 1104 Fourth Ave. E., Oskaloosa, formerly of Grinnell, died Sunday, Aug. 17 at University Hospitals in Iowa City.

Funeral services were conducted at the First Baptist Church in Oskaloosa, with the Rev. Lillian Dean officiating. Masonic services were conducted at 7 p.m. Tuesday. Burial was in Forest Cemetery.
