Mrs. Dayton rites today

Funeral services for Gurna Dayton, 82, of Denver, Colo., a native of Grinnell who died Jan. 29 at a nursing home in Englewood, Colo., were conducted at 11 a.m. today at the Nevenhoven Funeral Home in Brooklyn.

The Rev. Fred Pierce of the Grace United Methodist Church of Brooklyn officiated, with burial at the Ivy Hill Cemetery, Malcom.

The daughter of John and Lollie Stewart Edwards, she was born on Dec. 5, 1901, in Grinnell. She attended school here and taught rural school in Madison Township.
