

Herman DeBondt Dies Wednesday In Hospital

Herman DeBondt died in a local hospital Wednesday, February 1st.

The deceased was a native of Holland, born there on October 26th, 1857. He came to the United States with his family at the age of seven and resided in the Pella community.

He was married to Elizabeth Barendrecht on August 13th, 1886. The two farmed near Sully and were the parents of four children. The first Mrs. DeBondt died on January 3rd, 1918.

The deceased was later married to Minnie Brom of Newton, who died in 1950.

Preceding him in death, other than his wives, were two daughters, Mrs. Carrie Antle and Mrs. Anna Myers; 2 brothers and 3 sisters.

Surviving are: Sons Henry of Grinnell and John of Des Moines; 6 grand children and 16 great grandchildren.

Funeral services will be conducted by the James Funeral Home on Friday at 2 p.m. Rev. Otto Zwanziger and Rev. John DeLong will officiate. Interment will be in Our Silent City Cemetery at Kellogg.
