The son of Albert Justin and Cora Belle Burwell DeHart, Mr. DeHart was born near Earlham, Iowa, on Sept. 5, 1899. He attended school at Earlham and at York College, York, Neb.

On June 6, 1926, he married Georgia Stream at Creston, Iowa. To this marriage two sons were born—George A. DeHart of Bettendorf, Iowa, and Donald D. DeHart of Webster City, Iowa.

Mr. DeHart was a social welfare director and had served in

Des Moines, Creston and Webster City before retiring and moving to Grinnell 5½ years ago. He was a member of the Acacia No. 176 Masonic Lodge of Webster City, the Tribune Commandery No. 41 Knights Templar of Webster City, and Beulah Chapter No. 47 of the Order of the eastern Star in Grinnell.
