Emeline S. Scott was born at St. Johns, New Brunswick, Dec. 23, 1838, and died Sept. 15, 1903. She moved with her parents to Princeton, Ill., in 1854. She was married to Jeremiah M. Dee, Aug. 12, 1862, at Princeton, Ill. From Ill. she moved with her husband to Brooklyn, Iowa, in 1865 and to the present location in 1870. To them were born six children, two boys and four girls. Mrs. Frank Wolcott, Mrs. George Herman, deceased; Wm. Dee, Mrs. Homer Herman, Mrs. Moses Robbins and Chas. Dee, who died in infancy.

She united with the Christian church early in life and was a woman who feared God and trusted in Him. She was not afraid to die but said, "It is the Lord's will, I am not afraid to go. His will be done."

The funeral services were held at the Sheridan M. E. church, Sept. 18, 1903, conducted by Rev. D. Phillips. The remains were laid to rest in the Sheridan cemetery. May God abundantly bless and comfort the bereaved family. 9-29-1903
