Donald Deppe rites today

Donald R. Deppe, 37, of Rock Creek Lake died Monday evening of an apparent heart attack while attending a circus in Grinnell.

Funeral services for Mr. Deppe were conducted at 10:30 a.m. today at the Smith Funeral Home, with the Rev. Alfred L. Schulz of the Kellogg-Sully Lutheran parish officiating. Organist was Kathleen Heffner, and pallbearers were Albert Deppe, Ron Deppe, Roger L. Close, David Krumm, David Krumm Jr. and M.L. (Bud) Pagel. Burial was at Rock Creek Cemetery.

The son of Henry and Elsie Shill Deppe, he was born July

30, 1942, in Grinnell. He attended area schools.

On May 4, 1968, he was married to Susan Elizabeth Peters, the daughter of Grinnell Police Chief Bill Peters, in Grinnell. He had been employed for over 10 years at DeKalb AgResearch here and recently was employed by the Jasper County Road Department. He had also farmed in the Rock Creek area.
