

Eugene Dewey Services Held

Funeral services for Eugene E. Dewey, 64, Sully, former Grinnell resident, were held Saturday at the Sully Community church with the Rev. Maurice Dunker officiating.

Mr Dewey died suddenly last Wednesday.

Born June 11th, 1895, at Hamilton, Mo., he was the son of Eugene and Elizabeth White Dewey. He was married to Cora Jane Innis and to this union two daughters and one son were born: Mrs. Lloyd (Frances) Beason of Norwalk, Calif.; Mrs. Orville (Thelma) Foster of Newton; and Walter of Norwalk, Calif. His wife died in Sept., 1943.

On Oct. 18th, 1952, he was married to Bessie Renaud at the Little Brown church at Nashua. They had made their home in Sully the past eight years.

Retired he was last employed by the One Minute Washer Co. of Kellogg. Previously, he had been employed for 18 years by the Richardson-Phelps Lumber Co. of Grinnell.

Surviving besides his wifeand children are nine grandchildren, four great grandchildren, three brothes, two sisters, three step daughters one step son, seven step grandchildren and two step great grandchildren.
